- 4. Consistency and standards (consistency)

- 7. Flexibility and efficiency of use (efficiency)
- 8. Aesthetic and minimalist design (design)
- 9. Help users recognize, diagnose, and recover from errors (recovery)
- 10. Help and documentation (help)
