### 1. Speech acts

What is the sentence type, the direct and indirect speech act expressed by the following utterances.

- (1) Legolas's mother: Eat your Lembas, young man!
- (2) Legolas's mother again: Your tree house is tidy tonight or there's no more orc hunting!
- (3) Legolas drops his full coffee mug on Gimli's white warg-skin carpet, to which Gimli reacts with:
  - Are you serious?
- (4) Legolas: Alas, what darkness has befallen this white rug!

#### 2. Felicity conditions

What felicity conditions have to be met in order for the following utterance to have an effect on the interlocutor?

(5) You are banished forthwith from the Kingdom of Rohan, and all its demains, under pain of death.

## 3. Dad jokes

- (6) A little boy ran up to me "please help, my Dad is in a fight". I followed and we came across two men fighting. I said, "Ok, which one is your Dad?"..
  - .. I dunno, that's what they're fighting about
