Theresa Selent: Who are you?

Akay: I'm Akosia from Obuasi in Ghana. But people call me Akay.

Theresa Selent: And why did you come to

Kumasi?

Akay: I came here for an internship.

Theresa Selent: Okay. So you studied in

China but you are from Ghana, right?

Akay: Yeah, from Ghana.

Theresa: And why did you decide to study in

China?

Akay: Well, I didn't get the place here. I tried. But I didn't get it. So in China it was cheaper. So yeah, it was cheaper than Europe, cheaper than U.S. so I decided to go.

Theresa Selent: So before you went there did you do any research or was it like you wanted to do medicine and this was the best opportunity?

Akay: No, actually my cousin was there. And she had a good experience.

Theresa Selent: You have lived in China now for some years and you lived in Ghana in different places what would you consider your home?

Akav: Ghana.

Theresa Selent: Ghana.

Akay: I think home is where family is.

Theresa Selent: And how do you feel living in this sort of campus area?

Akay: It's cool, right? It's okay.

Theresa Selent: And does it mean anything to you, is it like maybe home away or something you feel that is close to home?

Akay: The campus?

Theresa Selent: Yes.

Akay: It's a temporary home.

Theresa Selent: And in terms of Kumasi and working in Ghana? Would you want to stay here or where would you want to work?

here or where would you want to work?



Akay: No. Not here. I have so much I want to do. So much I want to study. Maybe when I'm done, here. But I'm not done so everything is open.

Theresa Selent: But will you go back to China?

Akay: Yeah.

Theresa Selent: *But only to write the exams?*

Akay: Yeah.

Theresa Selent: ...or do you have to do something...?

Akay: ...no, I want to continue with surgery so I have to go to another country for that.

Theresa Selent: *But you want to go to another country for that?*

Akay: Yeah.

Theresa Selent: *Where would you want to go next?*

Akay: Maybe Germany?

Theresa Selent: And why do you want to go to another country?

Akay: I want experiences from everywhere. I want to learn all the experiences in the whole wide world and bring it to my country.

Theresa Selent: And do you feel it's easier for you to live and work in another country?

Akay: I don't think it will be easier for me to live and work in another country but I just will survive, so...

Theresa Selent: *And how was China for you?*

Akay: At first, oh I wanted to come back home but then my mum told me that if you have a goal in mind, use that. So I had a goal in mind to finish school. So I did that.

Theresa Selent: So it wasn't so much something you always wanted to do, to be abroad. It was something you had to do?

Akay: Yeah, I had to. But when I went there I realized it was a good experience. I met a lot of people. I met a lot of countries and I realized everybody thinks different so it was a good experience.



Theresa Selent: Now you are here in Kumasi. Do you feel like this is a special place or is it just any other medical campus to you?

Akay: It is just like any other medical campus.

Theresa Selent: *Okay. Do you feel good with your decision of studying in China?*

Akay: Yeah.

Theresa Selent: And are you happy now that you can spend some time here?

Akay: Yeah, definitely.

Theresa Selent: *Are you looking forward being a doctor?*

Akay: Yeeaaahhh. But I think I'm not ready yet.

Theresa Selent: Do you think with the education you get here in Ghana and the medical training you can be as good as a doctor as you want to be or do you feel maybe the resources or the technology will limit you in any way?

Akay: No. The resources are stretched. I feel we are more advanced in particular diseases because we see them more. So I want to experience from all over the world because in every other country they are more advanced in a particular disease or particular area.

Theresa Selent: So it's more medical interest you have?

Akay: Yeah. I don't care about technology or anything. Medicine is medicine. In this field the knowledge is more. And I want to have all the knowledge.

Theresa Selent: *Do you have many international friends and colleagues?*

Akay: Yeah. A Lot.

Theresa Selent: *And how do you stay in touch with them?*

Akay: WhatsApp, Skype, sometimes we talk. I plan on visiting them when they go back in their countries.

Theresa Selent: And if you look back before going to China did you feel like you want to go out and see the world before you went to China?

Akay: No. But now I want. And I want to go to every single country and visit my friends.

Theresa Selent: *That's a nice thing.*

Akay: Yeah, travelling is fun. To get to know other peoples culture I think is fun.
